15 16	A. A conviction of operating a motor vehicle without a license if the license had expired and was not suspended or revoked; and
17 18	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2551-A, sub-§3, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 606, Pt. A, §7, is amended to read:
19 20	B. A conviction of operating after suspension when the suspension is based upon a failure to pay child support.: and
21	Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §2551-A, sub-§3, ¶C is enacted to read:
22 23	C. A conviction of operating after suspension when the suspension is based solely on a failure to pay the reinstatement fee required by section 2486.'

25 26 27	This amendment, which replaces the bill, excludes a conviction for "operating after suspension" as an offense used to define "habitual offender" when the suspension upon which the conviction is predicated is based solely on failure to pay a reinstatement fee.
