HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 157,
L.D. 454, Bill, "An Act To Provide Representation for Dog Clubs on the Animal Welfare
Advisory Council"

Amend the amendment on page 1 by inserting after paragraph O the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the blocked paragraph in the last line
(page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Association." the following:
'In making the appointment of the person holding a kennel license issued under section
3923-C, the Governor shall consider nominations made by state-based dog clubs.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Governor to consider nominations made by state-based
dog clubs in making the appointment of the person holding a municipal kennel license to
the Animal Welfare Advisory Council.
