3	§111-B. Municipal budget matters
4	Notwithstanding section 111, a person who is at least 18 years of age and a citizen of
5	the United States and who is an owner of real property in a municipality may vote in an
6	election on a municipal budget matter for that municipality. If the person is not registered
7	to vote in the municipality, the municipal clerk shall confirm the person's eligibility to
8	vote under this subsection by referencing the municipal tax roll.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill allows a nonresident owner of real property in a municipality to vote on
11	municipal budget matters in that municipality as long as the nonresident property owner
12	is at least 18 years of age and a citizen of the United States.
