10	Amend the resolve by inserting before section 1 the following:
11 12	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
13 14 15	Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by the agency; and
16 17	Whereas, immediate resolution of eligibility and other issues is necessary for children with disabilities affected by this resolve; and
18 19	Whereas, the Department of Education must engage in emergency major substantive rulemaking to resolve these issues for children with disabilities; and
20 21 22	Whereas, there is an immediate need to ensure that emergency implementation of rules be undertaken to minimize any harm that might come to children as a result of application of current practices; and
23 24 25	Whereas, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to direct the Department of Education to engage in emergency major substantive rulemaking to resolve these issues; and
26 27 28 29	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it'
30 31 32	Amend the resolve in section 1 in subsection 5 in the last line (page 1, line 25 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section." and inserting the following: 'section; and be it further'
33	Amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:
34 35	'Sec. 2. Emergency major substantive rules. Resolved: That the Department of Education shall adopt emergency major substantive rules pursuant to the Maine

HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 188, L.D. 489

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9 10 Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A as soon as practicable but not later than June 30, 2009 to implement the provisions of section 1.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause and requires the Department of Education to engage in emergency rulemaking.
