SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 361, L.D. 516, Bill, "An Act To Require That a Majority of the Members of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission Reside in the Commission's Jurisdiction"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the indented paragraph in 6th line from the end (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "jurisdiction" the following: 'or residents of municipalities adjacent to the jurisdiction'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows the residential requirement to be fulfilled if a member is a resident of a municipality adjacent to the commission's jurisdiction.
