1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1100-B, sub-§3, ¶C**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 600, Pt. A,  
3 §88, is further amended to read:

4 C. The procedures incidental to the procedures specified in paragraphs A and B, as  
5 defined by the board, including the taking of x-rays by a dentist before providing  
6 and fabricating any denture. A dentist may not take an x-ray without possessing a  
7 dental radiographer's license issued pursuant to section 1100-J. A dentist may own  
8 x-ray equipment.
