An incorporated civic organization issued a license in accordance with this section shall provide the names of those who will be serving alcoholic beverages at the public event or gathering being sponsored. In the event that a server from that list is unavailable, a licensed manufacturer, distributor, wholesaler, farm winery or small brewery that has provided alcoholic beverages to be served at the event may provide serving assistance.'
