1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1071, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	6. Farm wineries. If wine from a farm winery licensed under section 1355 subsection 3 is served at an event under this section, an owner, employee or designated representative of the winery may serve the wine at the event.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9	This bill allows an owner, employee or designated representative of a Maine farm winery to serve wine from the winery at an event at which an incorporated civid organization is licensed to serve or sell liquor.
