

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	CONCEPT DRAFT
3	SUMMARY
4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to authorize the State to contract with an outside entity to establish
6	a casino in Maine. Under the bill, the State would have control over all aspects of the
7	development of the casino including the location, negotiating the specific terms of the
8	agreement with the operator and the distribution of profits. The license to operate would
9	be subject to a formal bid process in order to ensure the greatest return to the State.
