Cosponsored by Senator GOOLEY of Franklin and Representatives: CEBRA of Naples, HOGAN of Old Orchard Beach, PEOPLES of Westbrook, ROSEN of Bucksport. 1 Sec. 1. Moratorium on dealer plate reduction. Resolved: That, 2 notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 903, the number of 3 dealer plates lawfully possessed by a motor vehicle dealer may not be reduced from 4 February 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010 solely because of a failure to meet minimum sales 5 requirements under section 903, subsection 3; and be it further

6 Sec. 2. Retroactivity. Resolved: That this resolve applies retroactively to 7 February 1, 2009.

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SUMMARY

9 This resolve places a moratorium from February 1, 2009 to August 31, 2010 on 10 reducing the number of dealer plates a motor vehicle dealer may have based on a failure 11 to make minimum sales requirements.
