1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. P&SL 2001, c. 45, §2-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5	Sec. 2-A. Power generated. Power generated by the hydropower facilities must first be allocated to the paper production facilities located in Millinocket and East Millinocket.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9	This bill requires that the GNE, LLC hydropower facilities must give the paper mills operated in Millinocket and East Millinocket first priority when allocating generated power.
