Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, our state parks are open seasonally; and

Whereas, revenue from sales of merchandise will be greatest in the summer months; and

Whereas, increased funding for the operation and maintenance of our state parks is essential; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the 3rd line from the end (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "State." the following: 'Goods and services purchased by the bureau for sale or lease under this section must be procured in accordance with Title 5, chapter 155.'

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill would establish a new fund, the State Parks Improvement Fund, within the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands. It would require an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Department of Conservation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 2008-09, \$7,500 in fiscal year 2009-10 and \$10,000 beginning in fiscal year 2010-11 for the purchase of material for resale.
