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6 7 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1100-B, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

<u>2-A. Edentulous arch. "Edentulous arch" means a maxillary or mandibular arch</u> that is devoid of or absent any teeth or roots, but that may include implants.
