or detention of that person, the person refuses to stop on request or signal of a law enforcement officer, which is a Class E crime; uses physical force against the law enforcement officer, which is a Class D crime; or creates a substantial risk of bodily injury to the law enforcement officer, which is a Class D crime. The amendment maintains the defense to prosecution that the person reasonably believed that the person attempting to effect the arrest or detention was not a law enforcement officer. The amendment also adds the defense that the law enforcement officer acted unlawfully in attempting to effect the arrest or detention for the offense of refusing to stop on request or signal of a law enforcement officer. It also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
