1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
² 2 ,	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13104, sub-§7, ¶D is enacted to read:
3	D. A snowmobile owned or under the control of a snowmobile manufacturer may be
4 .	operated without a Maine registration at a demonstration event organized to occur in
5	this State if such operation is approved by the commissioner. A snowmobile
6	manufacturer or a representative of a snowmobile manufacturer must submit a
7	request in writing to the commissioner at least 60 days prior to the demonstration
8	event and shall include a description and the location of the event.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill allows a snowmobile owned or under the control of a snowmobile
11	manufacturer to be operated without a Maine registration at a demonstration event
12	organized to occur in this State if such operation is approved by the Commissioner of
13	Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.
