Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

**TRANSPORTATION, DEPARTMENT OF
Maintenance and Operations 0330**

Initiative: Allocates funds for the cost of reimbursing municipalities for Priority 3 and Priority 4 sand and salt building projects that were identified by the Department of Transportation as of January 2009. Funds allocated for this purpose may not lapse but must be carried forward to the next fiscal year.

This bill allocates \$1,275,500 from the Highway Fund for the purpose of providing funds to municipalities for the construction of Priority 3 and Priority 4 sand and salt sheds.
