1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10752, sub-§7 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	7. Nonresident member of United States Armed Forces. A member of the Armed Forces of the United States who is not a resident of the State but who owns property in the State is eligible for a resident fishing, hunting or combination fishing and hunting license or permit.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill allows a member of the United States Armed Forces who is not a resident of the State but who owns property in the State to purchase a resident fishing, hunting or combination fishing and hunting license or permit.
