Sec. 5. Bill authorized. Resolved: That the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over conservation matters may submit a bill relating to public access to the Dead River to the First Regular Session of the 125th Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the resolve. It directs the Department of Conservation to seek to acquire a public right-of-way along approximately 16 miles of the Lower Enchanted Road, from Route 201 in West Forks Plantation westward to an area used for vehicle parking and launching watercraft into the Dead River. It specifies that the department is not required to assume an obligation to improve or maintain the right-of-way at public expense. It directs the department to seek private and public funds to secure public access via easements or fee acquisitions. It requires the department to report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over conservation matters no later than January 10, 2011 and authorizes the committee to submit a bill to the First Regular Session of the 125th Legislature.
