The State Archivist must be qualified by special training or experience in the field of history or archival work. The State Archivist shall hold holds office for a term of 6 years from the date of the appointment, unless removed

This bill requires that the State Archivist have specific training and allows the holder of the position to be removed for cause under the Civil Service Law. The bill also fixes compensation for the State Archivist within salary range 88.
