

2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12501, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:
• 4 •	B. A nonresident fishing license to a nonresident 12 14 years of age or older.
5	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12501, sub-§6, ¶D, as amended by PL 2005, c. 12, Pt. III, §24, is further amended to read:
. 7 8	D. A nonresident junior fishing license, for persons $\frac{12}{14}$ years of age or older and under 16 years of age, is \$9.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill allows a nonresident under 14 years of age to fish without a license.
