13	(12) One member, appointed by the Governor, who is a tribal member and
14 15	provides services through a tribal program to tribal members who are victims of domestic or sexual violence.'
16	SUMMARY
17	This amendment clarifies that one member of the Maine Commission on Domestic
18 19	and Sexual Abuse be a tribal member and provide services, as part of a tribal program, to tribal members who are victims of domestic or sexual violence.
