COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 289, L.D. 742, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Composition of the Maine Commission on Domestic and Sexual Abuse"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (12) (page 2, lines 7 to 8 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'(12) One member, appointed by the Governor, who is a tribal member and provides services through a tribal program to tribal members who are victims of domestic or sexual violence.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that one member of the Maine Commission on Domestic and Sexual Abuse be a tribal member and provide services, as part of a tribal program, to tribal members who are victims of domestic or sexual violence.
