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

2	Resolved: That, notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 10109,
3	the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is authorized to and shall transfer the
4	Phillips Fish Hatchery in the Town of Phillips to the Sandy River Land Trust, a nonprofit
5	land trust in Phillips whose goal is to protect the riparian habitat within the Sandy River
6	watershed.
