1 .	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11154, sub-§14 is enacted to read:
3	14. Persons to whom a permit has never been issued. Notwithstanding this
4	section and section 11552, subsection 2, the commissioner shall set aside 1,000 moose
5	permits each year that must be part of a lottery held only for residents who have applied
6	for a permit for at least the 3 consecutive immediately preceding years and have never
7	been issued a moose permit.
