1 2	Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A by striking out all of paragraph B (page 1, lines 14 and 15 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
3	'B. May sell wholesale generation service in excess of its retail generation service as
4	part of providing retail service in accordance with paragraph A.'
5	SUMMARY
6	This amendment changes the provision in the bill regarding the sale of wholesale
7 -	generation service. The amendment specifies that a consumer-owned transmission and
8	distribution utility located in the territory administered by the independent system
9. 0	administrator for northern Maine may sell wholesale generation service in excess of its retail generation service when that sale of wholesale generation service is made as part of
1	providing retail service.
