Fiscal Detail and Notes

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This bill limits disbursements from the Ground Water Oil Clean-up Fund for administrative expenses, personal services and equipment costs to 5% of the balance of the fund. This fiscal note calculated the 5% on the average balance of the fund from fiscal years 2006 to 2008 of \$10 million or \$500,000 for a limit on disbursements. The annual budget for the department currently is \$5.5 million. In order to reduce the program costs to the \$500,000 limit, \$5 million would be eliminated. Deallocations of \$5 million are included in this bill to eliminate 43.3 positions for a cost reduction of approximately \$3,600,000 and for \$1.4 million in other program reductions. The cost reductions of \$5 million will prohibit the Department of Environmental Protection from participating in a federal matching grant program for Underground Storage Tanks. This would result in a loss of matching revenue of \$800,000 and ongoing deallocations of that amount are included in the bill. This bill also includes ongoing allocations of \$20,000 for annual audits.
