Sec. 1. Develop proposed policy. Resolved. That the Department of

policy to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government no later than
December 3, 2009. After review and receipt of the report, the Joint Standing Committee
may report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.
