COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 351, L.D. 929, Bill, "An Act To Expand the Moose Hunting Season"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11552, sub-§2, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A, §2 and affected by c. 614, §9, is amended to read:

B. The length of the moose hunting season, except that the moose hunting season may be no less than 3 weeks; and

Sec. 2. District classification. Under rules adopted by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the classification of Wildlife Management District 2 must be the same as that of Wildlife Management District 3 for purposes of moose hunting. Rules adopted under this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and provides that the moose hunting season may be no less than 3 weeks long. It also provides that Wildlife Management District 2 must be the same classification as Wildlife Management District 3 for purposes of moose hunting.
