Sec. 1. Department of Conservation to create all-terrain vehicle trai
through Pittston Farm. Resolved: That the Department of Conservation, through
the Land for Maine's Future Fund, shall acquire a sufficient right-of-way to create an all
terrain vehicle trail that enters and leaves Pittston Farm in Rockwood, Maine. The
Department of Conservation may use eminent domain if necessary to carry out the
purposes of this resolve.

SUMMARY

This resolve requires the Department of Conservation, through the Land for Maine's Future Fund, to acquire a sufficient right-of-way to create an all-terrain vehicle trail that enters and leaves Pittston Farm in Rockwood, Maine, using eminent domain if necessary.
