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

2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §42, sub-§3-C is enacted to read:
3	3-C. MaineCare rules; estimate of costs to providers. When adopting, amending
4	or repealing a rule pursuant to the administration of the MaineCare program, the
5	department shall provide an estimate to providers of services of anticipated costs that may
6	reasonably result from the adoption, amendment or repeal of that rule.
