

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §1702, as amended by PL 2001, c. 27, §1, is further amended
3	by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
4	The Public Advocate must be unencumbered by direction from or approval of the
5	executive branch in fulfilling the duties and responsibilities set forth in this section.
6	SUMMARY
7	Under current law, the duties and responsibilities of the Public Advocate are to
8	represent the public in matters within the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission
9	This bill provides that the Public Advocate must be unencumbered by direction from or
0	approval of the executive branch in fulfilling those duties and responsibilities.
