SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 671, L.D. 969, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing the Maine Children's Growth Council"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

**Sec. 3. Funding.** Expenses and per diem reimbursement for legislative members on the Maine Children's Growth Council may be funded from the legislative account for fiscal year 2009-10 but may not be funded for fiscal year 2010-11 or any subsequent fiscal year unless such funding is authorized by the Legislative Council.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows expenses and per diem reimbursement for Legislators on the Maine Children's Growth Council to be funded for fiscal year 2009-10 but prohibits funding in fiscal year 2010-11 unless such funding is authorized by the Legislative Council.

## Fiscal Note

Legislative Cost/Study - Decreased cost

### Legislative Cost/Study

This amendment authorizes funding for the per diem and expenses of the Legislators on the Maine Children's Growth Council in fiscal year 2009-10 only. These costs are estimated to be \$1,285. The estimated costs to the Legislature of \$2,570 annually beginning in fiscal year 2010-11 are not authorized and are contingent on future approval by the Legislative Council.
