4 5 6	L. Oil and hazardous materials emergency response workers in the employment of the Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Response Services who participate in a standby rotation on January 1, 2002 or are hired thereafter; and
7 .	SUMMARY
8	Under current law, retired oil and hazardous materials emergency response workers who worked in the Division of Response Services in the Department of Environmental
10	Protection are covered under the 1998 Special Plan. This bill extends inclusion in the
11	plan to oil and hazardous materials emergency response workers in other divisions in the
12	Department of Environmental Protection.
