COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 385, L.D. 1021, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit Cruel Confinement of Calves Raised for Veal and Sows during Gestation"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4020 in subsection 3 in paragraph G in the first line (page 1, line 33 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "birth" the following: 'and until the sow's litter is weaned'
