23 24 25 26 27	This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, clarifies that a municipality may adopt or enforce an ordinance that provides that a corporation or other business entity may not be afforded any constitutional rights, privileges, powers or protections that would enable the corporation or other business entity to avoid the enforcement of an ordinance or challenge an ordinance.
