1 particular, the focus of the stakeholder group will be to explore ways and make
2 recommendations to address childhood behavioral disorders, attention-deficit and
3 attention-deficit hyperactivity disorders, autism spectrum disorders and child obesity
4 through nutritional strategies that include food choices and dietary supplementation. The
5 departments will present the work of the stakeholder group to the Joint Standing
6 Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs and the Joint Standing Committee on
7 Health and Human Services and may suggest legislation to the joint standing committees,
8 which may in turn submit legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 124th
9 Legislature.
