Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services to study issue of homeless 17 veterans. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services 18 within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management shall work 19 with the existing groups that work on the issue of homelessness among veterans to 20 determine possible solutions to the issue and further assistance that can be given to 21 homeless veterans in the State and shall develop a report on their findings. The report 22 must include an estimate of the effect that additional veterans services officers would 23 have on the issue of homelessness among veterans; and be it further Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Maine Veterans' 24 25 Services shall submit the report developed under section 1 no later than January 15, 2010 26 to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs including any 27 recommended legislation to address the issue of homeless veterans. The Joint Standing 28 Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs is authorized to report out legislation to the 29 Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature based on the report.' 30 SUMMARY 31 This amendment replaces the resolve and directs the Department of Defense, 32 Veterans and Emergency Management, Bureau of Maine Veterans' Services to work with 33 existing groups to examine the issue of homeless veterans and recommend possible
