COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 774, L.D. 1119, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Municipal Jurisdiction of a Portion of Saco Bay"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "~~equitable.~~" the following: 'Notwithstanding the 3-mile seaward boundary of the town of Old Orchard Beach, the islands of Bluff and Stratton remain as part of the city of Saco.'
