1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1005** is enacted to read:

3 **§1005. Hiring family members prohibited**

4 A person may not be hired as an employee, as defined in section 1002, subsection 1,
5 paragraph A, of a school administrative unit for a position for which that person's spouse,
6 child, parent or sibling or the spouse of the person's child or sibling serves in a
7 supervisory capacity with respect to the person.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill prohibits a person from being hired as an employee of a school
10 administrative unit for a position for which that person's spouse, child, parent or sibling
11 or the spouse of the person's child or sibling serves in a supervisory capacity with respect
12 to the person.
