COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 804, L.D. 1165, Bill, "An Act To Improve Children's Safety in Public Swimming Pools"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 5th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "this subsection" the following: 'provided federal funds are available to cover all costs associated with this enforcement activity'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention to enforce the federal law only if federal funds are provided to cover the costs of enforcement.
