SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 805, L.D. 1166, Bill, "An Act To Implement the Recommendations of the Ad Hoc Task Force on the Use of Deadly Force by Law Enforcement Officers Against Individuals Suffering From Mental Illness"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph and section 15 (page 1, lines 14 to 28 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill in section 12 in the last line (page 3, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "process." the following: 'The board is not required to provide an electronic version of the training.'


SUMMARY

This amendment provides that when the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy incorporates specific training on mental illness as a component of the police tactical team certification process, it does not have to provide an electronic version of the training. The amendment also strikes the appropriations and allocations section.

This amendment states that an electronic version of the mental illness and involuntary commitment process training does not need to be provided. As a result, the General Fund appropriation and Highway Fund allocation have been eliminated.
