1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §523, sub-§5,** as amended by PL 2005, c. 683, Pt. A, §§47
3 and 48, is further amended to read:

4 **5. Special commemorative decals for medals awarded.** The Secretary of State
5 may issue special commemorative decals for use with special veterans registration plates
6 to any person who served in the United States Armed Forces, was honorably discharged
7 and was awarded a medal described in paragraphs A to Q when that person's application
8 is accompanied by the appropriate military certification verifying that the medal was
9 awarded to the applicant. One set of commemorative decals may be issued for each set of
10 special veterans registration plates issued under this section. One set of 2
11 commemorative decals must be displayed on the front and back plates. The fee for a set
12 of commemorative decals may not exceed \$5.

13 Special commemorative decals may be issued to applicants awarded the following
14 medals:

- 15 A. Distinguished Service Cross;
- 16 B. Navy Cross;
- 17 C. Air Force Cross;
- 18 D. Silver Star;
- 19 E. Distinguished Flying Cross;
- 20 F. Bronze Star;
- 21 G. Soldier's Medal;
- 22 H. Navy or Marine Corps Medal;
- 23 I. Airman's Medal;
- 24 J. Coast Guard Medal;
- 25 K. Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal;
- 26 L. European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal;
- 27 M. Korean Service Medal;
- 28 N. Vietnam Service Medal;
- 29 O. Southwest Asia Service Medal;
- 30 P. Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal;
- 31 Q. Kosovo Service Medal;
- 32 R. Korea Defense Service Medal;
- 33 S. Global War on Terrorism Medal;
- 34 T. Iraq Campaign Medal; ~~and~~
- 35 U. Afghanistan Campaign Medal;
