COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 818, L.D. 1179, Bill, "An Act To Create a Post-judgment Mechanism To Provide Relief for a Person Whose Identity Has Been Stolen and Falsely Used in Court Proceedings"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2183 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "If" and inserting the following: "In cases involving a criminal conviction, if"

This amendment limits the right to appointed counsel for indigent petitioners to cases involving criminal convictions.
