SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 445,
L.D. 1197, Bill, "An Act To Improve the Maine Clean Election Act"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in paragraph B in the last line (page 2, line 10 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "~~year~~" the following: 'or the next business day following April 20th if the office of the commission is closed on April 20th'

SUMMARY

This amendment extends the qualifying period for State Senate or State House of Representatives candidates participating in the Maine Clean Election Act until the next business day if the office of the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices is closed on the last day of the qualifying period.
