13	SUMMARY
14	This amendment strikes that portion of Committee Amendment "A" that requires a
15	benefits incurred to premiums earned loss ratio of 78% for one year or 80% over a 3-year
16	average in the small group insurance market. This amendment also strikes language from
17	Committee Amendment "A" that specifically exempts from the definition of "public
18	records" information in filings that is protected health information required to be kept
19 20	confidential by state or federal statute and descriptions of certain information in contracts between insurers and 3rd parties.
