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

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §313, as amended by PL 1999, c. 745, §1, is further amended by
3	adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
4	Notwithstanding this chapter, a person who acts as a lobbyist or a lobbyist associate
5	for a nonprofit organization as defined in Title 5, section 1660-D, subsection 17 whose
6	only compensation for that lobbying is reimbursement for travel expenses and the
7	employer of that person are exempt from the requirement to pay a registration fee in this
8	section.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill provides that a person who acts as a lobbyist or a lobbyist associate for a
11 12	nonprofit organization whose only compensation for that lobbying is reimbursement for
13	travel expenses and the employer of that person are exempt from the requirement to pay a registration fee.
