13 14 15	'6. Exemption. The provisions of this section do not apply to the delivery sale of large cigars to an adult consumer purchaser. For the purposes of this subsection, "large cigar" means a cigar that weighs more than 3 pounds per 1,000.
16	SUMMARY
17 18 19	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It exempts delivery sales of large cigars to adult purchasers from the prohibition on delivery sales of tobacco products to consumers.
