HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 850, L.D. 1230, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit the Delivery of Tobacco Products to Consumers To Prevent the Sale of Tobacco Products to Minors"

Amend the bill in section 4 in §1555-F by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

'6. Exception. This section does not apply to sales of pipe tobacco or large cigars, as those terms are defined by 27 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 40.11 (2008).'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an exception for pipe tobacco and large cigars, as those terms are defined under federal law, to the bill's proposed ban on direct-to-consumer delivery sales of tobacco products.
