COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 858, L.D. 1239, Bill, "An Act To Establish a Revenue Source for the Maine Pesticide Education Fund"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide Funding To Educate Homeowners in Integrated Pest Management'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Transfer from the Board of Pesticides Control to University of Maine Cooperative Extension. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$50,000 by August 1, 2010 from the Board of Pesticides Control program, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to the UM Cooperative Extension - Pesticide Education program, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the University of Maine System.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM, BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
UM Cooperative Extension - Pesticide Education Z059**

Initiative: Allocates one-time funds for the homeowner integrated pest management education program. The university may not assess facilities or administration charges on this grant.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation includes a one-time transfer of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2010-11 from the Board of Pesticides Control, Other Special Revenue Funds account in the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to the University of Maine Cooperative Extension program. The \$50,000 is a grant to be used for educating homeowners in integrated pest management.

The bill also includes a one-time Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2010-11 to the UM Cooperative Extension - Pesticide Education program within the University of Maine for educating homeowners in integrated pest management.
