COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 860, L.D. 1241, Bill, "An Act To Require Licensing for Certain Mechanical Trades"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Directing the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation To Conduct a Sunrise Review Regarding the Proposal To License Certain Mechanical Trades'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to conduct a sunrise review regarding the proposal to license certain mechanical trades.

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation shall conduct an independent assessment pursuant to the sunrise review requirements in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 1-A, subchapter 2 of the proposal to license certain mechanical trades; and be it further

Sec. 2. Reporting date established. Resolved: That no later than February 15, 2010 the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation shall submit a report with any necessary legislation following the independent assessment under section 1 to the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development. That committee is authorized to submit legislation on the subject matter of the report to the Second Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee and replaces the bill with a resolve. It requires the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation to conduct an independent assessment pursuant to the sunrise review requirements in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 1-A, subchapter 2 of the proposal to license certain mechanical trades. It also requires that no later than February 15, 2010 the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation submit a report with any
